

Emergency Plans

The center now has a written risk management plan available for all to view if you are interested. This is a plan of how our staff will handle all emergencies from an intruder to a natural disaster. We will be as prepared as we can for anything that comes my way.

Emergency Child Kit

The center needs to be prepared for any type of an emergency. We are now requiring that each child have an emergency kit kept in his/her cubbie. The kit must include the following:

Juice box or sealed water bottle

Non-perishable snack

Full set of clothes

Family picture if you have one

Small coloring book and crayons.

Put all of the items in a gallon size zip lock bag that is labeled with your child's name

We never know when some type of an emergency will take place. The emergency could range from a tropical storm to a hurricane or to a terrorist act. I know it seems strange but we do need to be prepared if we need to evacuate the center. If this ever occurs there will be a message on the center phone giving directions to our location, a sign on the doors of the center and we will have our cell phones to contact you. This information is also on the website. We hope that we never have to evacuate however we will be prepared if one does occur during center hours.

Evacuation Places

We will evacuate to one of two places depending upon the situation. We will be at the Fire Station on Belair Rd or at Hazelwood Elem.
